This gem of a gift shop in the historic downtown of Fayetteville started off 2020 with their best sales quarter yet.

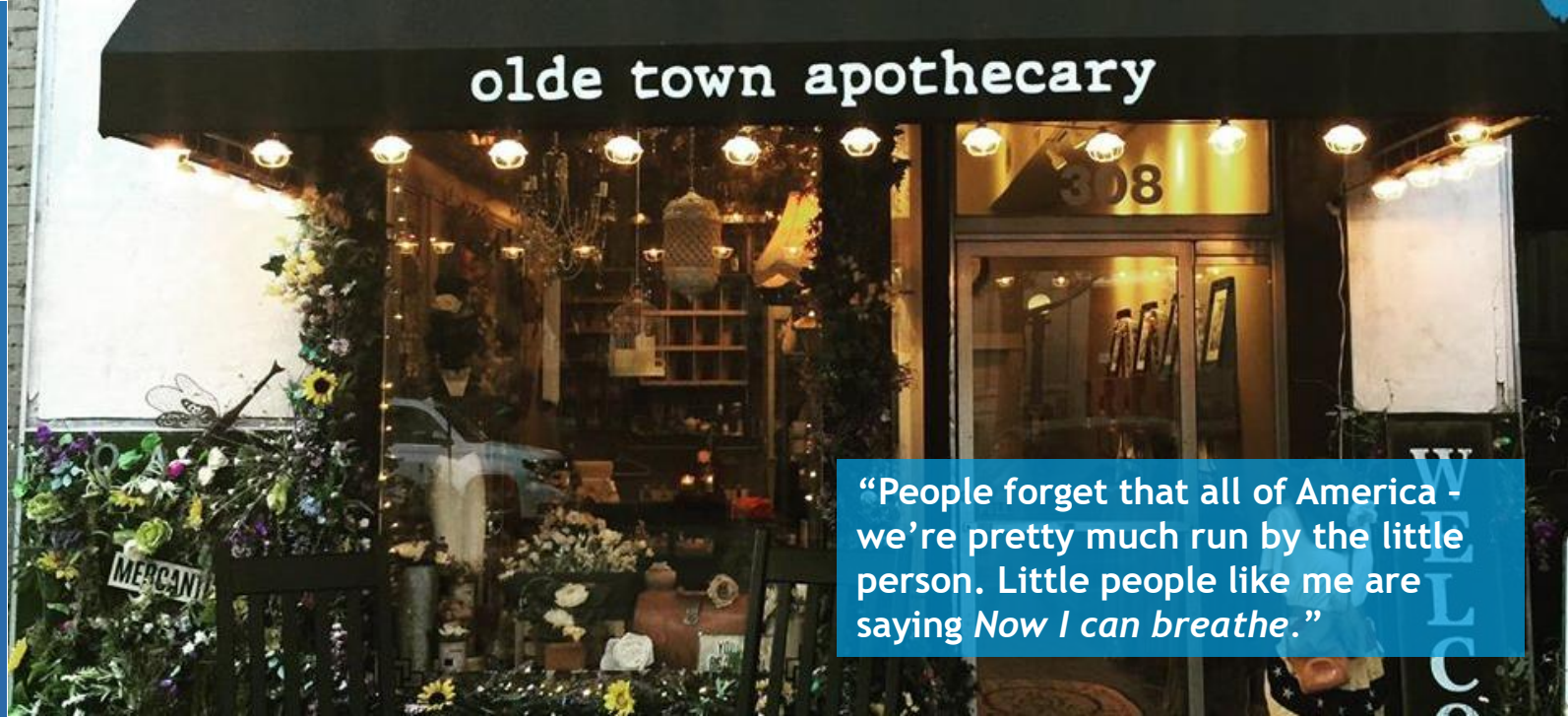
On March 23, after a week of no sales, owner Stephanie Aubrey made the difficult decision to close her store. A week later the governor imposed stay-at-home orders.
